TASTING NOTES

Rockabilly Red is a big time riot, luscious and bursting out of the glass with aromas of cherry cola, blackberries, vanilla and coconut. She crosses your lips with intensity and brings more blackberries, black forest cake, cherry cordial chocolates and spice.

FOOD PAIRING

Great on a weeknight with a quick sausage pasta. Bring this one out for BBQ or relax into the evening with a glass and some dark chocolate.

AWARDS

Silver Medal, 2021 National Wine Awards of Canada
91 Points, Geoffrey Moss MW. "These so-called 'hermitaged' blends, where a dollop of Syrah is added to Bordeaux red varieties, are becoming increasingly common in the Okanagan. And for good reason. This is complex, expressive, and pure, with a combination of black and red fruits that are heightened by a floral lift. Medium-full-bodied, this is quite extracted with dense, ripe tannins."

VINTAGE & WINEMAKING NOTES

An overall cooler 2019 vintage compared to recent years, punctuated by sunlight and clear skies resulted in wines with juicy and vibrant fruit, crisp acidity, balanced alcohol levels and all with the freshness synonymous with BC wine. Rockabilly Red has a mild oak influence, allowing it to be enjoyed early and often.
