TASTING NOTES

Nostalgia's dry, medium-bodied Pinot Gris is a bottled Okanagan memory of walking through the blossoms of orchards, enjoying fresh peaches, apples and pears. Like the Okanagan, she's beautiful year round!

FOOD PAIRING

Try with spot prawns in the spring, summer salads, spaghetti carbonara in the fall and pork roast with herb gravy in the winter.

VINTAGE & WINEMAKING NOTES

The 2021 season had a reduced yield, resulting in an intensely flavourful harvest. 2021 Pinot Gris was sourced from our Home Vineyard and from our valued grower partners in the South Okanagan. All hand picked then fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel vessels.
