TASTING NOTES

Nostalgia's dry, medium-bodied Pinot Gris is a bottled Okanagan memory of walking through the blossoms of orchards, enjoying fresh peaches, apples and pears.

FOOD PAIRING

Enjoy chilled with prosciutto-wrapped cantaloupe, spiced shrimp with peach salsa, or a pork chop skillet with pears and red onions.

VINTAGE & WINEMAKING NOTES

Although 2022 was cool to start, it enjoyed blue skies throughout the growing season and the sunny warm days of late summer and early fall ushered in outstanding fruit quality. 2022 Pinot Gris was sourced from our Home Vineyard, Cassini Vineyard (Oliver) and Border Vineyard (Osoyoos). All hand picked then fermented in temperature-controlled stainless-steel vessels.
