On the Black Sage Bench in Oliver BC, vintner and family farmer Gina Fernandes Harfman combines her passion for winemaking with her family's four generations of experience farming the South Okanagan terroir, to put forth a small lot lineup of wines that perfectly exemplify their vintage. At her woman-owned and run Nostalgia Wines, Gina invites you to make moments with what she has captured in the bottle, and create tomorrow's memories.

TASTING NOTES

Seductive black currant, blackberry, dark plum, sage, and spice aromas abound from this complex, harmonious wine. Appetizing acidity and a full texture create structure, while notes of small dark berry fruit, cocoa, coffee, earth and graphite add intrigue and persist on the finish.

PAIRING

Pairing ideas include veal, wild game, mushroom dishes, or aged cheese.

VINTAGE & WINEMAKING NOTES

The 2021 season had a reduced yield, resulting in an intensely flavourful harvest. All hand-picked and crushed on the day of picking. Aged 17 months in French and American oak, 40% of which was new.
